



The COBRA Container Lock is a removable lock for containers and trailers and consists of two parts and a padlock.

## Attachment

- Slide the red lock housing of the bar and attach the grey-coloured part over the mounting bracket of the rod on the left-hand door, and the red part over the mounting bracket of the rod of the right-hand door.
- Slide the red lock housing together as tightly as possible, so that the padlock bracket falls easily into the lock housing and the bar. Now install from underneath the lock part of the padlock and lock the padlock.
- Remove the key from the lock and your COBRA Container Lock is installed.

## IMPORTANT

- Make sure the key is fully inserted in the lock before attempting to turn it.
- To guarantee effective operation, the padlock must be cleaned regularly.
- Hang the lock as high as possible so it's difficult to reach.

**PLEASE NOTE: the fit that gives the least play between the locking bar and the bracket is the best.**

## Repair of SBS locks

## Maintenance of mechanical locks

The simplest solutions for keeping a trailer lock supple is to maintain it with lubrication spray such as Brunox Turbo Spray®. This multifunctional lubrication spray contains Turbo-line and has a fivefold effect. It is penetrating oil, lubricating oil, water dispersant, contact spray, cleaner and protection in one. Thanks to the handy powerclick system, you can spray in a very targeted manner using the small tube or atomise broadly for surface protection.

## Protective padlock cap

To protect your padlock, you can place a rubber protective cap on top. A protective cap such as this prevents dirt and water from entering the padlock. The rubber cap is designed in such a way that water can leave the padlock, but dirt cannot enter.

## Spare keys
